

This is a top-notch book, and follows a man who has to remove himself and his family from Jamaica after his greedy family turns against him and wrests his land away from him. He goes to England, eventually bringing his wife, and then his children, over, for a better life.

America is not the only country where immigrants experienced disillusionment. Clifford believes that England will treat him better than his family has, only to be given a rude awakening as he has to deal with racists who, like ignorant Americans, wrongfully blame immigrants for their woes.

I really liked the author's style. As I'm unfamiliar with Jamaican terms and some British slang, I am grateful

that the author added a word guide at the back of the book so I could look up any words that confused me. Some of the dialogue could be a bit hard to follow, but that's not the author's fault, as she nicely captured the feeling of patwa, and hen the dialogue reflects how people actually speak in that time and area, it makes the story feel more real.

Overall a really good book with a ending that in some parts, I did not expect. I only wish we could have learned more of what happened to Cliff's extended family, but honestly, that's just a quibble. This book is definitely work checking out. A+.
